Program Budget and Budget Narrative (20%)

- 15. It is evident that return on UWKV's financial investment would be high if outcomes are achieved.
- 16. Program plans to utilize UWKV funds effectively and efficiently to meet community needs.

Overall (10%)

- 17. The request fully aligns with UWKV's mission, vision and values.*
