Pacesetter, Kickoff & Celebration Location & Dates TBD

The **Pacesetter Breakfast** is an early campaign launch event for business partners, bringing together 100 people and 20+ businesses, who want to complete their workplace campaign before mid-September. Pacesetter businesses typically raise over 50% of UWKV's annual campaign and wrap-up by the Campaign Kickoff.

With close to 300 attendees annually, the **Campaign Kickoff** marks the official start of the fundraising season for UWKV, with the majority of workplace campaigns launching at this event. This event is a public event and the largest event of the year.

The **Campaign Celebration** marks the completion of the fundraising season. During the Campaign Celebration, which attracts 150+ attendees, UWKV announces fundraising results and presents awards to outstanding business partners. **Sponsorship levels include your support of all three events.**
