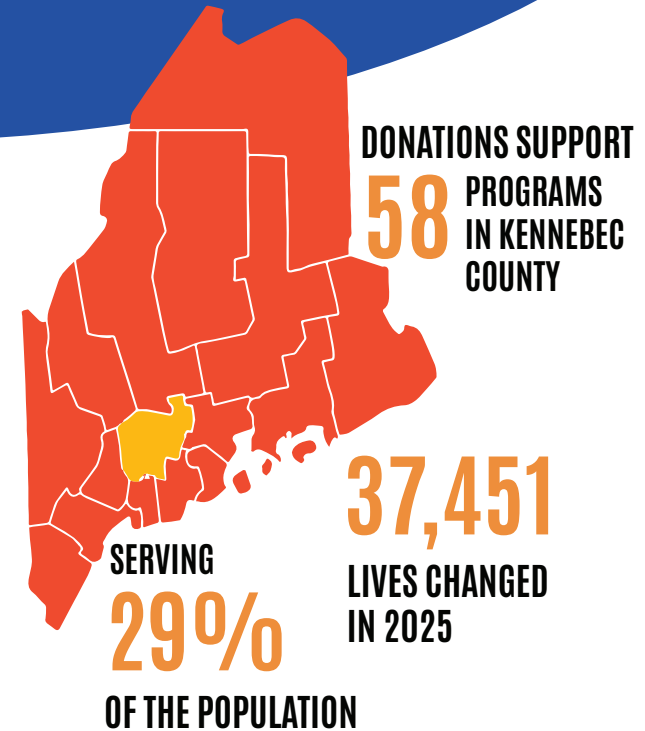
>> Day of Caring
